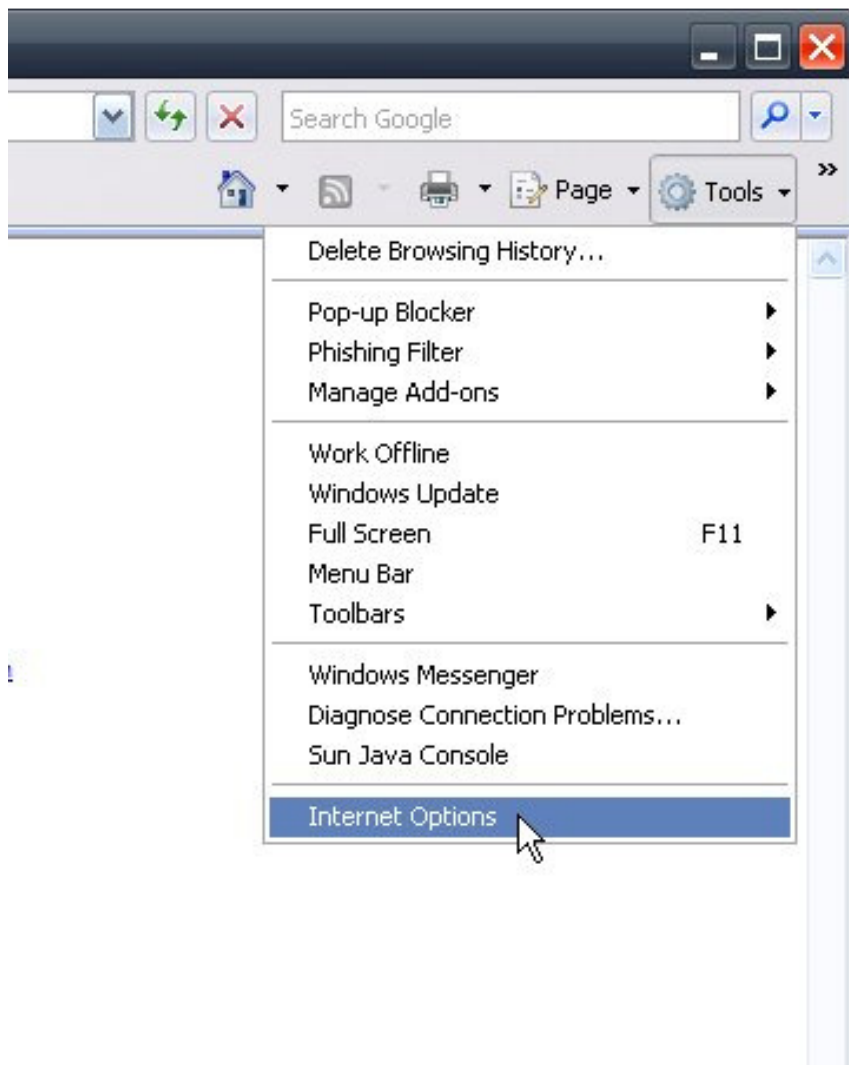


## Adjustment of Internet Explorer 7 settings

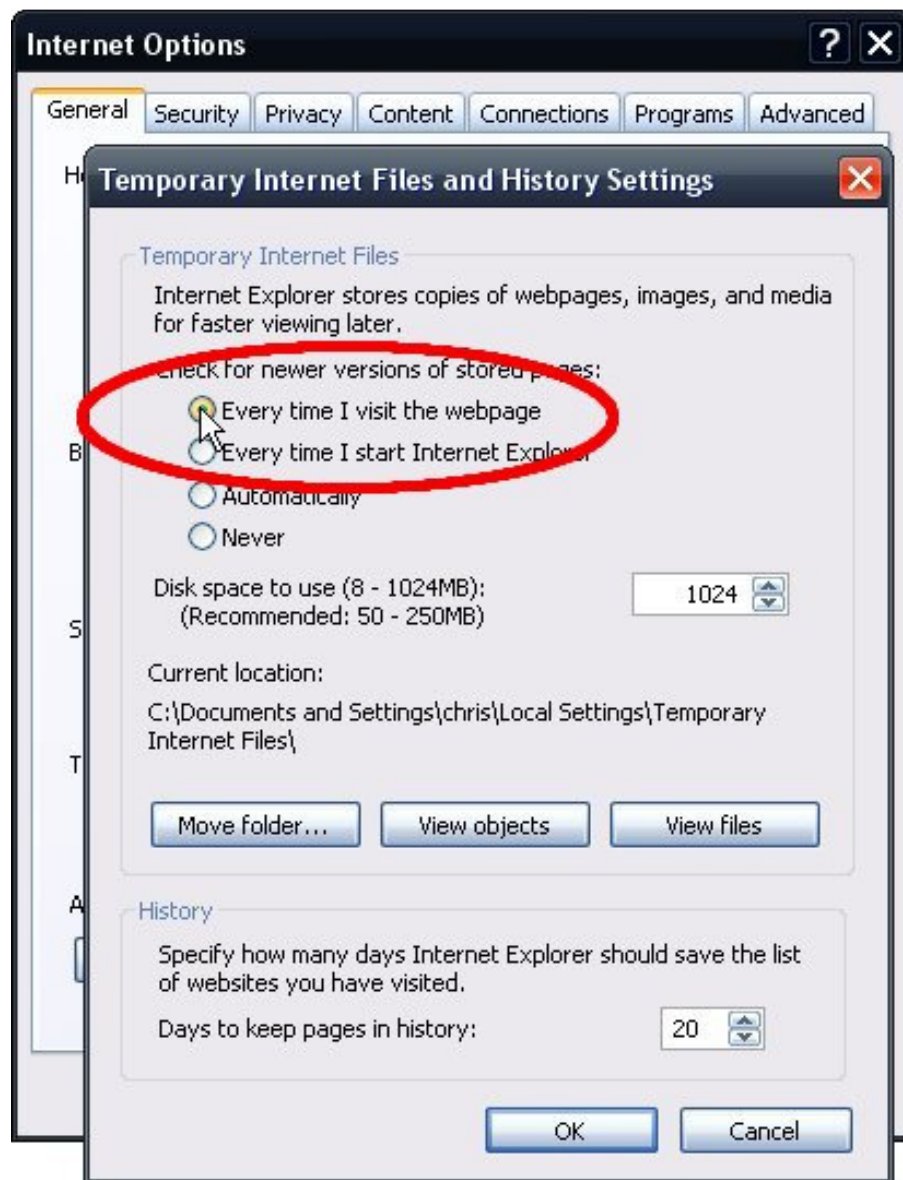
### Enabling the Update of websites with every visit

- Open Internet Explorer 7
- Click on the **Tools** menu and select **Internet Options**



- While still in the **Internet Options** dialog, click on the **General** tab, then from the **Browsing History** section, click

on the **Settings** button, make sure that **Every time I visit the Webpage** is selected.

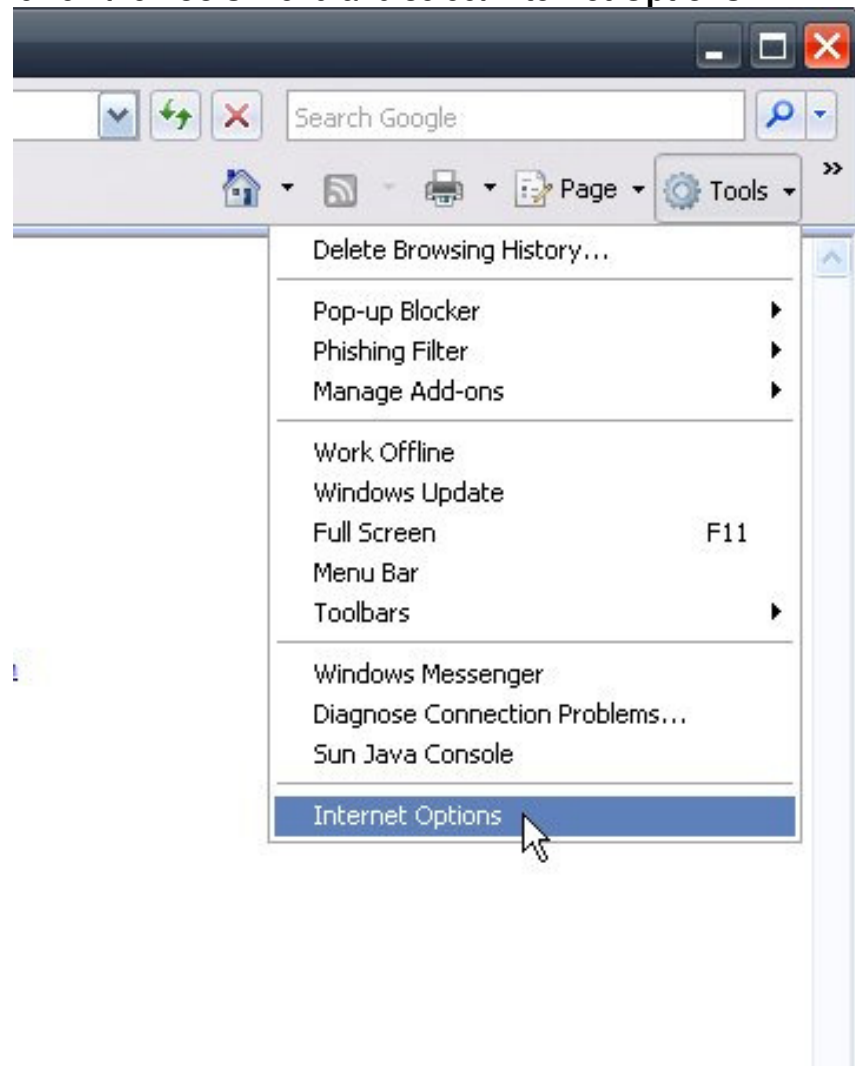


- Click **OK** twice to close the dialog boxes
- Close Internet Explorer 7 browser and reopen the browser to apply the settings

### Enabling Java script

- Open Internet Explorer 7

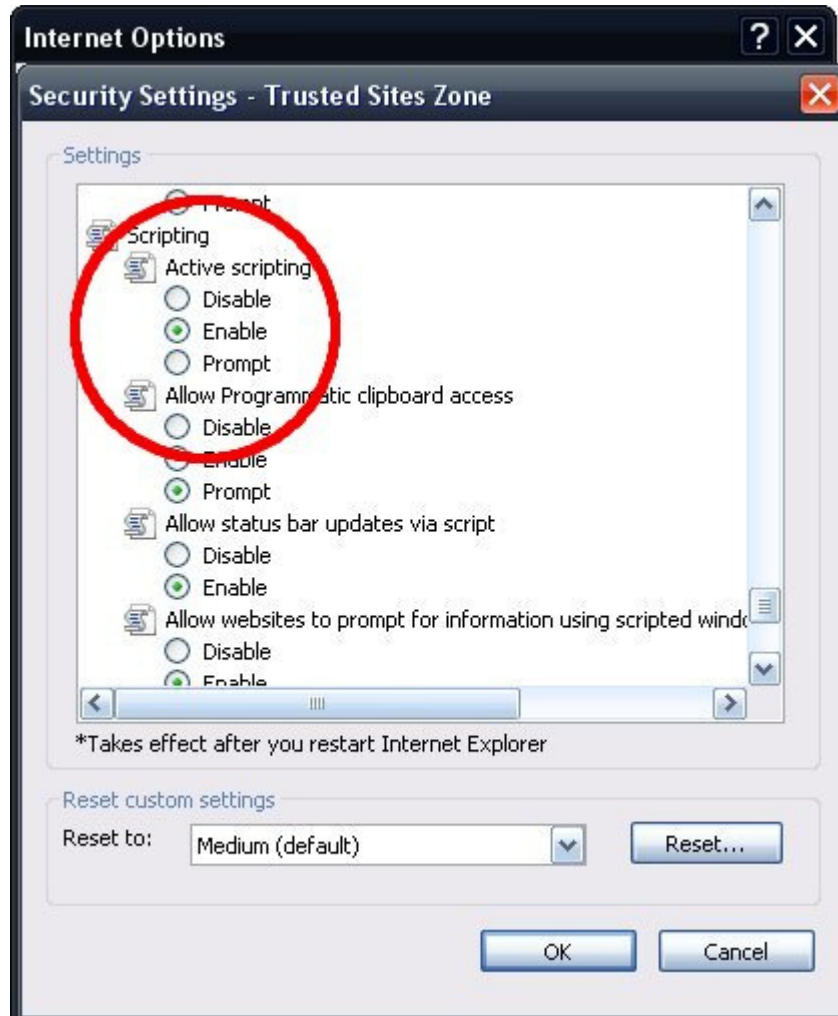
- Click on the **Tools** menu and select **Internet Options**



- Click on the **Security** tab



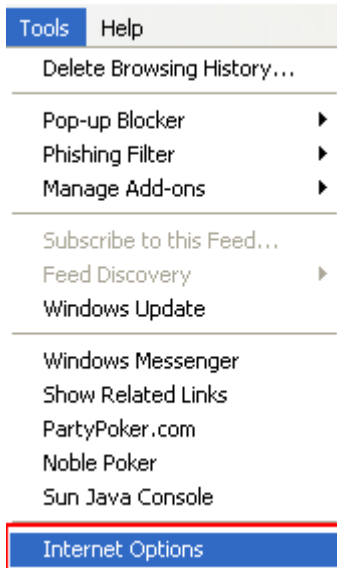
- Click on **Custom Level...** and another dialog box will appear. Scroll down till you get to the **Scripting** section. Make sure **Active Scripting** is set to **Enable**.



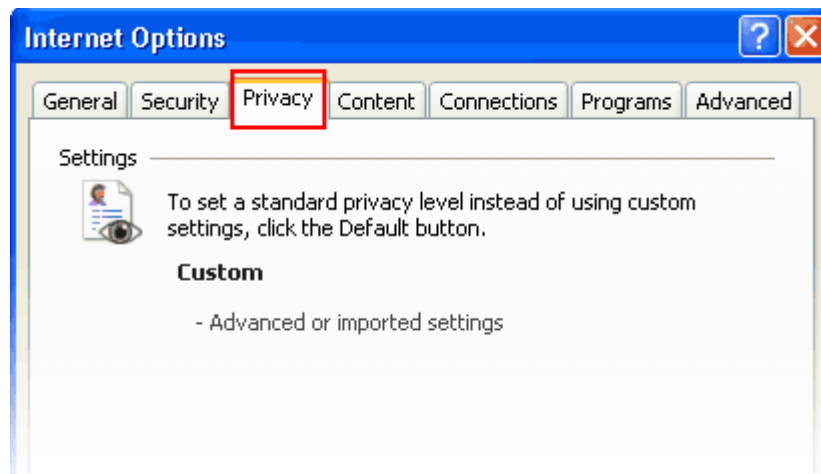
- Click **OK** twice to close the dialog boxes

### **Adjustment of Internet Explorer 7 to accept cookies**

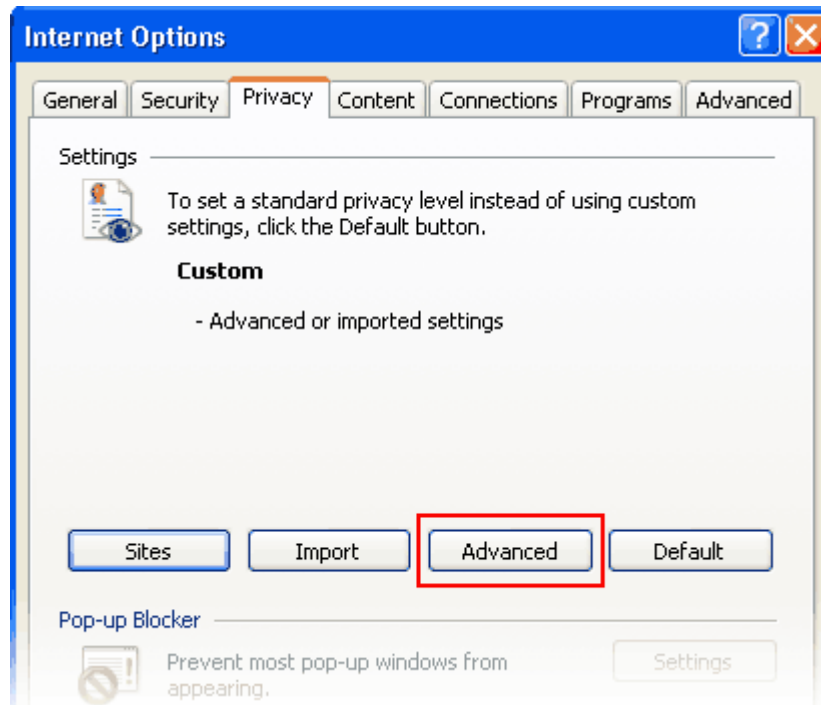
1. Start Internet Explorer 7
2. Under the **Tools** menu, click **Internet Options**



3. Click the **Privacy** tab



4. Click the **Advanced** button



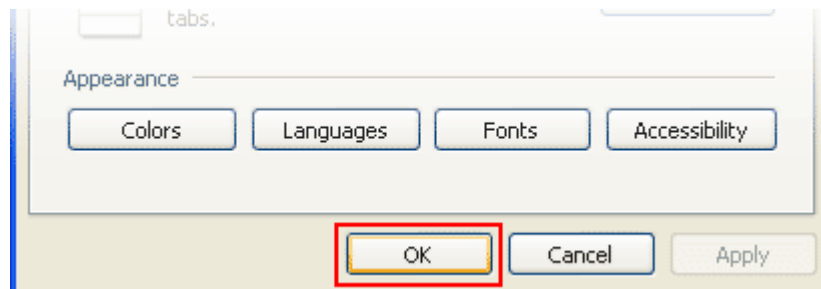
5. Put a check mark in the box for **Override Automatic Cookie Handling**, put another check mark in the **Always accept session cookies** box.



6. Click **OK**



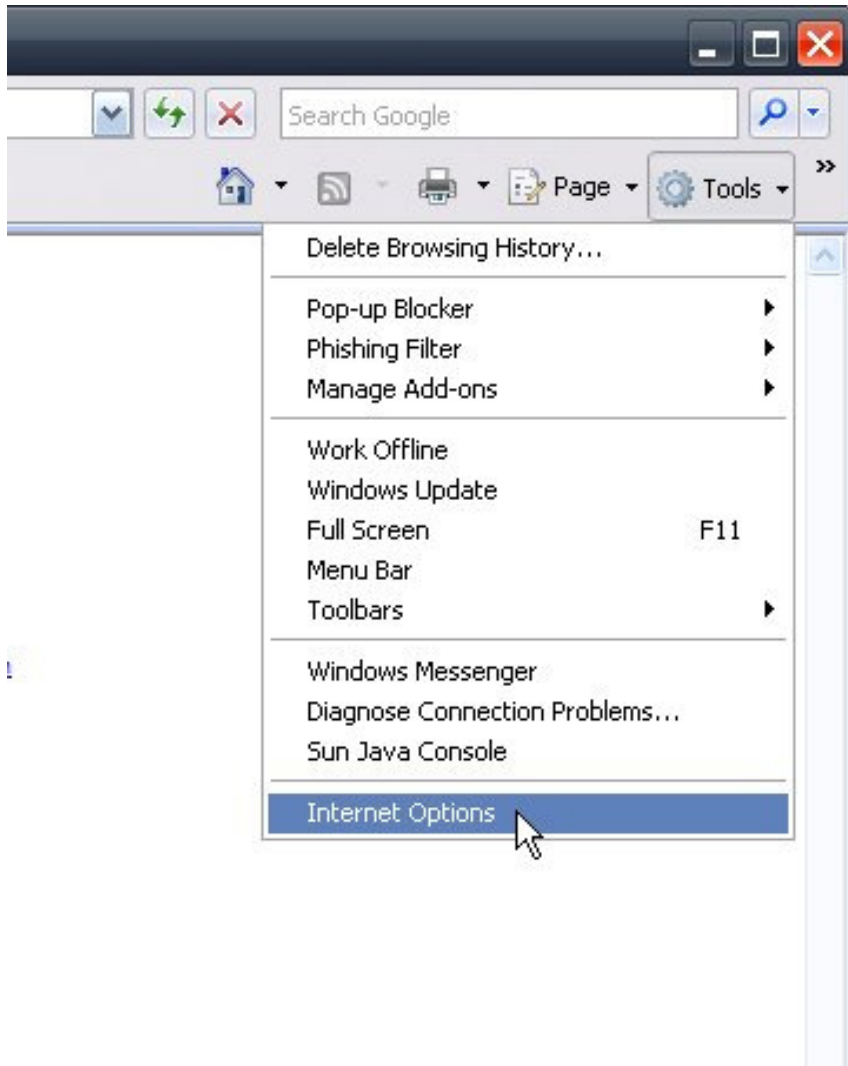
7. Click **OK**



### Disabling Third Party Browser Extensions

- You'll need to select Tools at the top of the IE window, then Internet Options (the last item)

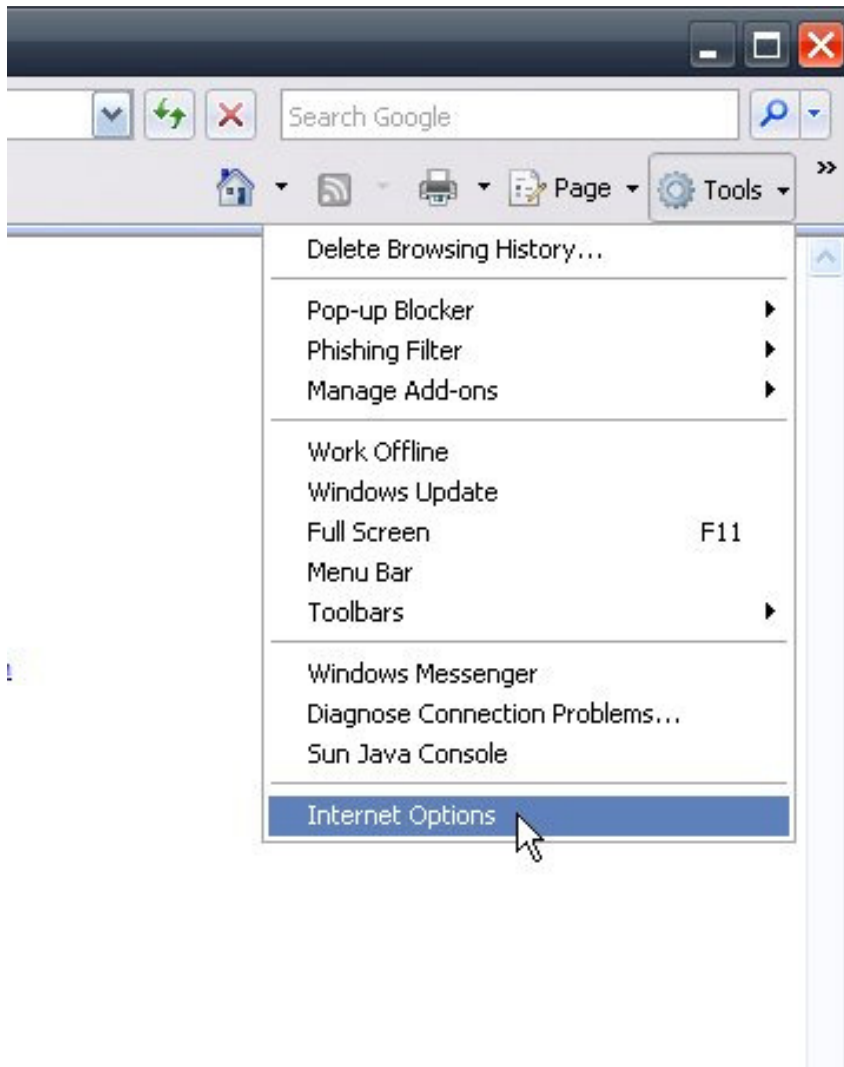




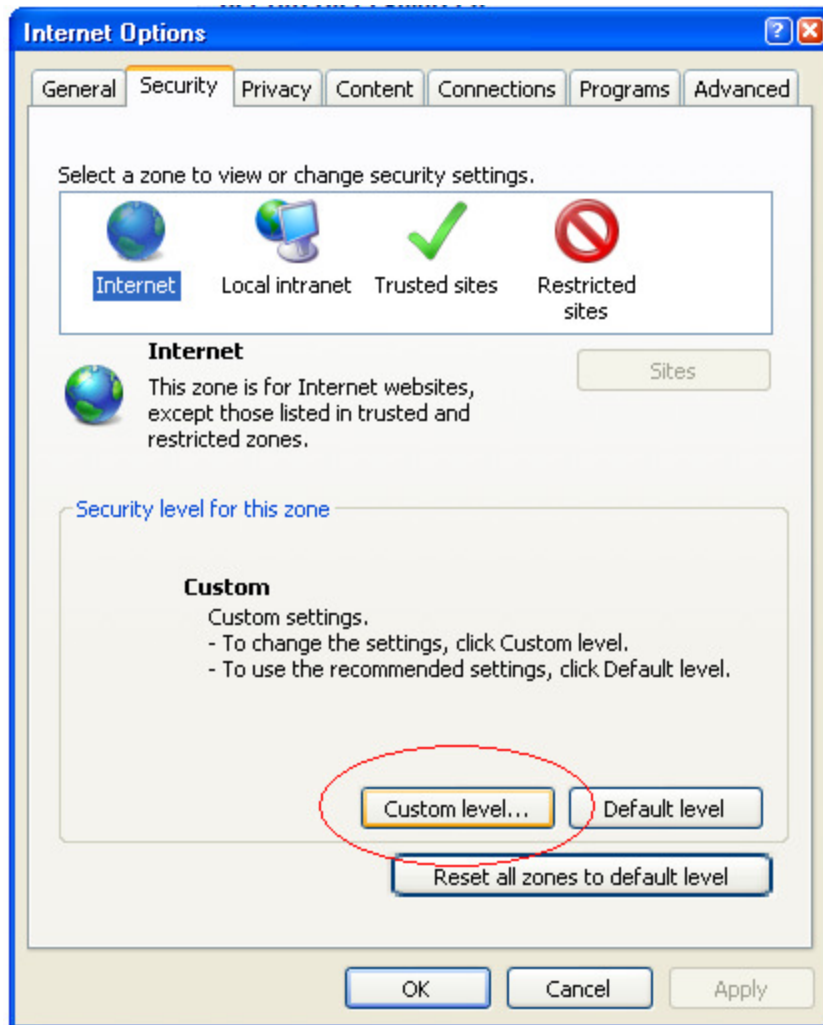
- Once you are in this screen you will want to select the Advanced tab in the upper right corner of that window
- Under the browsing section (second section down), you will want to find the one that says "enable third-party browser extensions"
- Make sure that box is Unchecked
- Click the Apply button in the lower right hand corner and then ok

## Enabling Mixed Content to Display

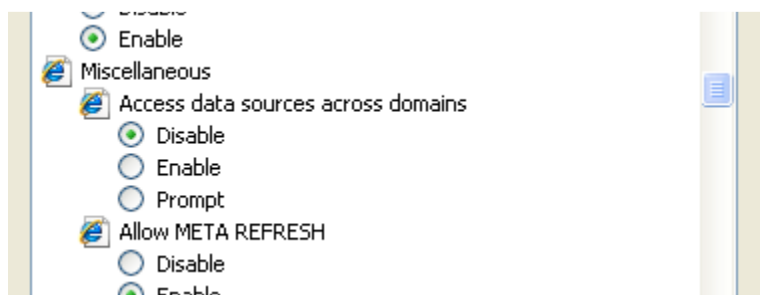
- You'll need to select Tools at the top of the IE window, then Internet Options (the last item)



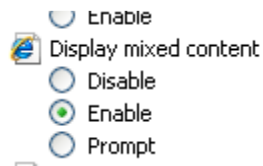
- Once you are in this screen you will want to select the Security tab at the top of that window
- Select the “Custom Level” button



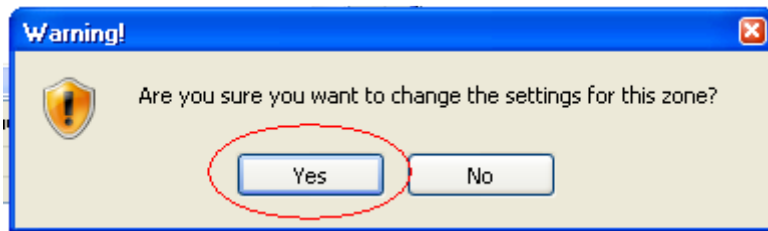
- Within that window, scroll down to the “Miscellaneous” section



- Under that section, you will see an item labeled “Display Mixed Content”



- You will want that Enabled
- Click the OK button at the bottom



- A window will pop up asking “Are you sure you want to change the setting for this zone?”
- Select “Yes”
- The window will return to the Internet Options page
- Select OK
- Restart the Internet Session to apply all changes made
